

FAA 107 Weather Journal Assignment

Objective: To understand the basic principles of weather as it relates to aviation and the FAA Part 107 regulations.

Instructions:

- 1. Read and review the FAA 107 Weather information on the FAA website. Take notes as you read and highlight key concepts that you want to explore further in your journal.
- 2. Select at least three types of weather conditions that are relevant to aviation, such as wind, clouds, precipitation, visibility, thunderstorms, or turbulence. Research each type of weather condition and write a summary of its characteristics and how it can impact aviation.
- 3. Choose a weather event that occurred in your area or other areas such as a thunderstorm, snowstorm, or tornado, and research how it impacted local aviation activities. Write a brief summary of your findings and include any photos or news articles that you find.
- 4. Reflect on the importance of understanding conditions for safe operations. Write a personal reflection on what you have learned and how this knowledge might apply to your future career or interests.
- 5. Write conclusion summarizing your key takeaways from this assignment and how you will apply this knowledge in the future.
