**Objective: To enhance understanding of FAA 107 regulations and their application in commercial drone operations.**

2. Choose three scenarios involving commercial drone operations and analyze how the regulations apply to each scenario.
3. Write a journal entry for each scenario, answering the following questions:

What are the applicable regulations for this scenario?

How do these regulations impact the operation?

What are the potential risks and safety considerations?

How would you mitigate these risks?
